

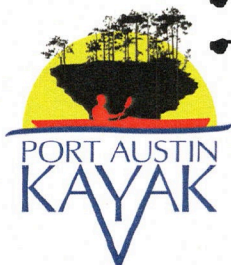
# Wilderness Trail - Bike Trail



Take country dirt roads to a historic cemetery, Port Crescent State Park or the Huron County Nature Center. Enjoy a hike or a swim before coming out of nature and back to town.

Approximately 10.5 miles.

- Head west out of the shop along Spring Street to Sand Road
- Left on Sand Road (at Gallup Park) to Port Crescent Road
- Right on Port Crescent Road, path to cemetery will be on your left
- Continue on Port Crescent Road to M-25 (Port Austin Road)
- Straight across the street is the access to trails that cross an old trestle (no bikes allowed on trails)
- Trails will lead to Pinnebog River and the beach
- Left on M-25 to Loosemore Road or Port Crescent Day Use Park (across the street from each other)
- Right into Day Use Park, follow road to beach and trails
- Left on Loosemore Road to Huron County Nature Center (trails)
- Return to shop the way you came or follow M-25
